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## NOTICE: APPLICATION FOR LEARNERS AND DRIVERS LICENSES FOR SCHOOL INSTITUTIONS

Msukaligwa Local Municipality under Department Public Safety / Licenses Section has launched an initiative for schools within Msukaligwa Local Municipality, in relation to the application for Learners and Driving Licenses, accordingly.

The Department of Public Safety urges learners to make necessary arrangements with their school principals for assistance in applying for their Learners and Driving Licenses.

### Points to note:

Application for Learners License Fee: R126.00 – Code B – EC  
Upon issue R37.00 is payable.

Application for Driving License Fee: R150.00 for Code B and Code C1 – EC the Fee is R184.00.  
These fees are subject to change:

Age for the Application of Learners license for Motor Cycle up to 125cc is 16 years.  
Age for the Application of Learners license for Motor Cycle above 125cc is 17 years.  
Age for the Application of Learners License Code B is 17 years.  
Age for the Application of Driving License Code B – C1 & EC is 18 years.  
Upon issue R170.00 is payable.  
These fees are subject to change.

### REQUIREMENTS:

#### LEARNERS LICENSE APPLICATION

LL1 Form / Application for Learners License  
2x Identity Photos  
Certified Copies of Identity Card/Book  
Proof of Address for the applicant / Lease agreement of the applicant  
Applications for Learners Licenses can be done on Mondays

#### DRIVING LICENSE APPLICATION

DL1 Form / Application for Driving License  
Certified Copies of Identity Card/Book and Learners License  
2x Identity Photos  
Proof of Address for the applicant / Lease agreement of the applicant  
Applications for Driving Licenses can be done on Wednesdays

**Note:** If the proof of address is not in the name of the applicant - then the registered owner of the registered address must declare in the form of an affidavit at the police station or the commissioner of oaths that he/she resides with the applicant and furnish his/her certified copy of Identity Document. A lease agreement of the applicant is acceptable as proof of address.
